### The Facts

Harvested	November 17th, 2014
Temperature	-15c
Alcohol	14.5%
Residual sugar	161 g/L
pH	4.25
Tartaric acid	6.9 g/L

### THE WINE

This wine is a rosy hue thanks to the freezing cold temperatures softening up the skins. Dried plum, strawberry, and fig aromas lead to a viscous texture and long finish.

### VINTAGE SUMMARY

An early spring led to an incredibly warm summer in 2014. In fact, it was the most heat we had seen since 2003, when our vineyards were still hayfields. After the long, warm fall somebody turned the heat off and we got hit with a nasty November cold snap. Nasty for us, but great for Icewine. It was one of the earliest Icewine picks on record and resulted in superb quality and fresh flavours.
